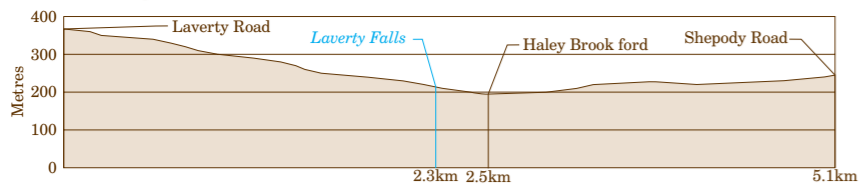


### Laverly Falls



**ROUTE:** 2.5 km to brook, another 2.6 km to Shepody Road (1 ford).  
**ACCESS:** two trailheads: off Laverly Auto trail and on Shepody Road.  
**AVERAGE TIME:** 1 - 1.5 hours to Haley Brook ford; another 1 - 1.5 hours to Shepody Road.  
**HIGHLIGHTS:** Curtain waterfall, hardwood forest on the slope mixing with conifers near the brook and out to Shepody Road, gradual slope out to the brook.

### Upper Salmon River



**ROUTE:** 4.5 km to Black Hole Trail, 8.4 km to The Forks Trail, 9.6 km to the Moosehorn Trail, 12.5 km to Laverly Falls.  
**ACCESS:** At Headquarters, also Laverly Falls, Moosehorn and The Forks. (Part of the Fundy Circuit)  
**AVERAGE TIME:** From Headquarters to Black Hole, 2 hours, Black Hole to Laverly Falls 3.5 to 4 hours.  
**HIGHLIGHTS:** Follows the water carved gorge of the Upper Salmon River, with spectacular potholes, waterfalls, salmon pools and rapids. Frequent fording and difficult hand and footholds, short steep sections between The Forks and Moosehorn.

### Coastal Trail



**ROUTE:** 3.2 km pool area to Herring Cove, another 6.9 km Herring Cove to Point Wolfe.  
**ACCESS:** three trailheads with parking near the pool, at Herring Cove, and at Point Wolfe east of covered bridge.  
**AVERAGE TIME:** 1 - 1.5 hours pool to Herring Cove, another 2 - 2.5 hours to Point Wolfe.  
**HIGHLIGHTS:** sea cliffs and vistas of Bay, ridge-top view of rolling hills, Matthews Head, Squaws Cap sea stack, fern glades and lush coastal forest.

### Fundy Circuit

**ROUTE:** 50 km loop linking six existing trails: Coastal, Marven Lake, Bennett Brook, Tracey Lake, Laverly Falls, and Upper Salmon River (see Fundy Circuit symbol on map).  
**ACCESS:** see access details for each trail.  
**AVERAGE TIME:** 3 to 5 days.  
**HIGHLIGHTS:** hike to many of the park's outstanding features: river valleys, coastal vistas, small woodland lakes, and hardwood slopes. Along the route are seven wilderness campsites and two campgrounds. Since most of the river crossings are on the Upper Salmon River, hike this part of the loop last, when your pack is lighter.

**IMPORTANT: Wilderness campers must register in and out with the Park Staff.**

### Dobson Trail

A 58.7 km footpath from Fundy National Park (Shepody Road at Laverly Falls trail) to Riverview, N.B. A guide book (English only) is for sale at the Fundy Guild sales outlet.
